“Do you know what you are reading” Acts 8:30

“Witnessing “and want to run a mile. Many
church people will bake a pie; work a sound
booth even clean the church but they don’t want
to “witness”

If you attend a church function and say the word
“Evangelism” a bit too loudly you might not
